TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Please review the following User Agreement carefully before using this web site. User should also read the SIX Magazine Limited PRIVACY POLICY.

1. Introduction

- 1.1. This website is owned and operated by SIX Magazine Limited.
- 1.2. These terms and conditions govern User use of this website ("Website"), including participation in discussion & leaving commentary on the BLOG and FEATURES pages ("Discussion Areas").
- 1.3. Please read the following terms and conditions carefully. This Website is designed to provide a platform for the robust and free-flowing exchange of information, opinions and comments, and an enjoyable and informative experience for everyone. User use of the Website will constitute User agreement to comply with these terms and conditions.
- 1.4. These terms and conditions may be modified by SIX Magazine at its own discretion. Continued use of the Website will constitute user acceptance of any changes to these terms and conditions, therefore it's advisable to check this page regularly.
- 1.5. User failure to follow the Website's rules, whether set out in these terms and conditions or posted at other locations on the Website, may result in termination of user access to the Website without notice.

2. Use of the Website by User

SIX MAGAZINE LIMITED PRIVACY POLICY STATEMENT

1. General

This policy covers the Website of SIX Magazine Limited ("SIX Magazine"). SIX Magazine is committed to safeguarding User's privacy online. The purpose of this privacy policy is to inform User what personal information SIX Magazine collects and the purposes for which it uses this information. In reviewing this privacy policy, please read our Website terms and conditions. 2. Disclosures

4. Use of personal information
